

Sports Premium Funding – Looking Forward

From April 2018 Heron Way Primary School have received £8,029 from, PE and Sport Premium, to improve PE and Sport Provision.

The majority of the Sports Premium Funding will again be used to employ a specialist sports coach. As seen in previous years there was a significant rise in the children's health and wellbeing as well as a vast improvement in their attitudes towards physical education due to this support.

Below illustrates the range of ways we plan to spend the money:

- Employing specialist qualified sports coach.
- Being an active member of Horsham and District Primary Schools Activities Association (HDPSAA).
- Significantly raising the profile of PE within our locality through involvement in tournaments.
- A significant increase in the range of after school sporting activities and continuing our focus on the involvement of girls.
- Training new play leaders.
- Providing CPD training for staff in PE lessons.

A survey was conducted by the staff to gather whether they feel or have seen a benefit from the Sports Premium funding and how we spend it. This was a huge success as all staff answered that they feel more confident teaching PE after have CPD training with our specialist sports coach. Some did add (20%) that they would like time to now plan further with them to aid their CPD even more and we are now looking at how to assess effectively in PE across the school. Now the staff are more confident in teaching lessons, we are now looking to buy new, advanced equipment to increase the range of lessons and skills we can teach the children. The survey also highlighted our increase of success in inter-school competitions and the improved range of sporting activities we offer to the children during and after school.
